



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
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Workshop selection ...

- 4. At the end of the workshop, sign-out on the Sign-Out Sheet that your presenter will share at the end of the session.





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Frequently Asked Questions

Do I have to check in at the registration desk each day?

No. Once you have checked in on the first day, you do not have to check-in each day, but you can always stop by and let us know how things are going or ask questions!

I need Act 48 Credit. Can I still get Act 48 Credit if I didn't indicate that I needed it during registration?

Yes. Check-in at the Attendee Registration Desk on the Main Floor to request the Act 48 Form. There is a \$25 charge for processing Act 48.

Can I use my cell phone during the conference?

Yes. You will need it to access the Whova App, but as a courtesy to presenters and other attendees, please turn off your cell phones or set them to vibrate during sessions and keynote presentations. Then, please quietly exit the room to attend to important phone calls.

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Frequently Asked Questions -- Food

I'm hungry ...

The last thing we want attendees to worry about is being hungry. If this is your first time at the Summit, let us assure you that you will not go hungry. Continental Breakfast is set up outside President's Hall beginning at 7:00 AM. Continental Breakfast typically includes Danish, bagels, fresh fruit, yogurt, cold cereal, juices, coffee & tea. On each floor, centrally located near the meeting rooms, there is a break area with various snacks, juices, soft drinks, coffee, tea, and water. They are replenished regularly throughout the day. We have a buffet lunch with hot and cold entrées

Will there be vegetarian options?

Attendees were asked to indicate any special dietary needs at registration. If you did not do so, we will try to work with the catering staff to accommodate your needs. Typically, there is at least one vegetarian option at the lunch buffet.
